

Stem-Changing Verbs: **o → ue**

For **o → ue** stem-changing verbs, the last **o** of the stem changes to **ue** in all forms except **nosotros(as)** and **vosotros(as)**.

poder *to be able, can*

puedo	podemos
puedes	podéis
puede	pueden

Stem-Changing Verbs: **e → i**

For **e → i** stem-changing verbs, the last **e** of the stem changes to **i** in all forms except **nosotros(as)** and **vosotros(as)**.

servir *to serve*

sirvo	servimos
sirves	servís
sirve	sirven

Nota gramatical: **Ver** has an irregular **yo** form in the present tense.

Veo un autobús.

Nota gramatical: Use a form of **ir a + infinitive** to talk about what you are going to do.

Stem-Changing Verbs: **e → ie**

For **e → ie** stem-changing verbs, the **e** of the stem changes to **ie** in all forms except **nosotros(as)** and **vosotros(as)**.

querer *to want*

quiero	queremos
quieres	queréis
quiere	quieren

Direct Object Pronouns

Direct object pronouns can be used to replace direct object nouns.

Singular

me	<i>me</i>
te	<i>you (familiar)</i>
lo	<i>you (formal), him, it</i>
la	<i>you (formal), her, it</i>

Plural

nos	<i>us</i>
os	<i>you (familiar)</i>
los	<i>you, them</i>
las	<i>you, them</i>

Nota gramatical: Use **tener** to form many expressions that in English would use *to be*.

Tengo frío. I am cold
