APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- Applicant must be a relative of a dues paying member of the IAHS of Birmingham, Alabama.
- · Applicant must be a high school senior accepted at a college or a college student.
- Applicant must submit a cover letter with a resume that includes the following:
 - his or her name, age, USPS mailing address, email, cell phone number, current year in school, name of high
 school attended or currently attends, school and community activities, the name of the relative who is a member of
 IAHS, the last four digits of his/her Social Security number (this number will be used to identify the applicant's
 essay for anonymous review by the selection committee. The selection committee will not see the cover page, so
 please do not staple the cover page to the essay.)
 - name and address of registrar of college currently attending or accepted to attend (payment of scholarship will be mailed directly to the school)
- Applicant writes and submits an essay of at least two (2) pages (typed, Times Roman, 12", double-spaced) explaining the topic, "What My Italian Heritage Means to Me."
- Deadline for submission is on or before May 31, 2024.
