The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria in the selection of scholarship recipients.

- ✓ Completion of Scholarship Application with all requested attachments
- ✓ Official Transcript, including Official GPA (Grades 9-First Semester, Grade 12)
- ✓ Cumulative ACT Score or Total SAT Score
- ✓ Evidence of involvement in School and Community Activities
- ✓ Recommendations from school official, community leader, etc. (Two (2) letters)
- ✓ Evidence of leadership qualities and ability
- ✓ Evidence of good written communication skills
- ✓ Evidence of good moral character (Letters of recommendation will verify)
- ✓ Acceptance to an institution of higher learning
- ✓ Enrollment in an institution of higher learning during the summer or fall session following selection graduation
